

At our recent Annual Meeting, we approved our new mission statement... "That all would know they are loved by God and are inspired to follow Jesus." We've set a course to Engage, Connect and Inspire. Last year's church president, John Fuls, challenged everyone last year to engage, and people really got engaged-many stepped forward in the life of Living Waters! This year church president DeNetta Wolbeck has called this The Year of **CONNECT.** We are invited to get connected, to grow our community within the walls of the church and outside the walls of the church. The Living Waters Church Council met recently for a retreat to focus on this current year, with Pastor Hans Dahl of the Calvary Partner Network, and Kia Kisthart, Partner Network Coordinator, whose church in Alexandria, MN, Calvary Lutheran, has received a grant from the Lilly Foundation to help Lutheran churches network about life as churches in changing times. Calvary is sharing lots of great support and resources with us and 11 other congregations currently. We're seeing some real life resulting from this partnership.

Connect Groups – We are building up and developing new small groups called "connect groups." Here's the vision—this year we'll develop clear strategy and invite members to be involved in groups and connect. We'll be recruiting group leaders, providing them with

intentional training, giving them access to resources needed to lead groups, and surrounding them with consistent support. Groups will be a place where people get a taste of Living Waters' authentic, irresistible culture. Groups will explore faith together, but may also gather people around enjoyed activities, such as softball, curling, hockey, lefse, body image activities, or something like Bambam Ball or Gaga Ball for youth. The Time and Talent Survey was sent out, and with the great response, we will be intentional about encouraging and equipping existing groups and helping to start new connect groups.

New Book Available for Connect Groups – The Book of Mark discussion groups went well, and as a resource for connect groups this coming month, we will have a new book available, *Set Apart* by Jennifer Kennedy Dean. It is about living as people who are loved and blessed by God, set apart to live as people loved by God, discovering the promise and fulfilment of the promise of God.

Watch for Connect Group News – As we will be communicating the vision, one could say that groups will be our "everything" this year as a focus. Connect groups will even be our tool for Outreach. Watch for more to come about a BIG Sunday and special event to launch groups. The vision for this year is that no one will be able to miss that groups are our thing at Living Waters!

The council did a lot of work on this plan last year, and now we will continue with the next phase to <u>Connect</u> and grow in both our congregation and community.

We will continue to look at what fits the Mission Statement — How do we grow our community within the walls of the church and outside the walls of the church. What do we need to change and/ or do to be welcoming and inviting to our guests and visitors so all know they are welcome.

What we currently do may need to be changed or tweaked, as we live, we grow and we learn by trial and error. Some activities or ministries may no longer be relevant and may work for a while, but then they need to fall away and make way for new ideas or just need tweaking so we can continue to evolve and thrive in these changing times.
