Week 3: Evan Almighty










#### CHRIST IN OUR HOME BOOKS AVAILABLE

# **Journey of Stones**

For Lent this year we are giving up stones. People will talk about things they might give up for Lent, things which they know may not be good for them. This year, for the Lenten Wednesday services, I invite you to come along on a "Journey of Stones," and we'll bring those things which weigh us down to set them at the foot of the cross, where Jesus takes them away, that we may have our load lightened by not carrying them around anymore.

Each Wednesday for Lenten services, first we will hear faith stories once again from people of Living Waters--a very meaningful part of Lent in this community of faith.

And we will listen to God's Word together and reflect also on the "stones" we carry around in life—stones of rejection and hurt which weigh us down, stones we may contemplate tossing at

someone else, hearts of stone unwilling to let God's love in.

Each week we will place a stone at the foot of the cross—lay at the feet of our Savior all of those things which separate us from him. Along the way, we will confess our faith, contemplate the truth about ourselves and stand together at the foot of the cross and lay our stones—and our sins—down, and leave in wonder of how God is lightening our load.

We will together journey through Holy Week in March and together proclaim the resurrection, to announce together the Good News, "He is risen!" We will see how we'd laid our sins at the cross and now, behold! They'll be gone. The stone will be rolled away! Thanks be to God.

Come and walk this journey beginning Ash Wednesday, February 14th at the 5:30 p.m. service. The following weeks we'll gather for soup suppers at 5:30 p.m. and then worship at 6:30 p.m.
