

(Note, the whole trip would include a couple days before and after the gathering to allow for travel). Josh Rock and Pastor Jake will be there to tell about the event and to answer questions.

May you be filled with joy in this season of fall, with the colors of God's handiwork all around us, and also with the variety of things happening at Living Waters as we grow together in faith, loved by God and called to follow where Jesus leads us.




