

"The beginning of the good news of Jesus Christ, the Son of God..."

Mark 1:1

We've got some new beginnings taking shape here at Living Waters Lutheran Church. One of them is a 21 day "Walk Through the Gospel of Mark" we'll be embarking on in September. This is how the Gospel of Mark starts out: "The beginning of the good news of Jesus Christ, the Son of God." That's the major beginning for us. And then throughout our lives, there are other new beginnings that happen all the time in the life of Christ followers as a result.

Over the course of a retreat and several meetings of the minds last spring, the Living Waters Church Council proposed new mission statement, "That all would know they are loved by God and are inspired to follow Jesus." We also landed on three things as the focus over the next couple years: Small Groups, Youth and Education, Engagement. Coming up this fall, now, here are some new beginnings which will be taking place in relation to the three areas of focus:

SMALL GROUPS – You are invited to join us for "**Table Talk**" Sundays at 10:15 a.m. beginning September 10th, Rally Sunday. Pastor Wayne Anderson and I will be leading informal discussion around the **Walk through the Gospel of Mark**,

Then three Small Groups options in October —in homes or a restaurant, at church after W.O.W. worship Wednesdays, and another at the Back Shed Brewery, with the Walk Through

the Gospel of Mark booklets. For other groups that would like to get started with different areas of interest this fall, we'll equip leaders who'd like to get one going. All groups will have the goal for people to grow together in faith.

YOUTH AND EDUCATION – For our fall kick-off, leaders are excited for the theme, "Ready, Set, Move!" with New Testament Bible stories from the Book of Acts.

Sunday School, 10:10 a.m. PreK-3rd graders will meet Sundays this year for classes with their leaders, beginning September 10.

Wednesday Education Pizza at 5:30, Family Night once/month—first one Kick-Off Wednesday, September 13th –parents invited to be there for pizza and a parents' & students' meeting.

H2O 9-12 grade youth group joins with Wednesday classes at "Kids Against Hunger" servant event September 27.


Choir Rehearsal Begins September 7


Worship and Music Team
